## **County and District Councillors**

**Cllr S Manion:** KCC have a duty of care for unaccompanied migrant children arriving in the county. The increased number or arrivals has put extreme pressure on the allocated budget and the Government has been asked to help. Covid-19 planning- a lot of work being done regarding getting school transport ready for the children returning to school in September.

The reporting and repair of pot holes is ongoing.

**Cllr O Richardson**: Council staff still working from home where possible. DDC continue to be coping well in the present situation.

**PCSO Steve Nodding** – Email report: Langdon Play area will be monitored following recent minor damage and evening activities. Speeding vehicles through Langdon – Resident are asked to monitor and report times (and registrations) of offending vehicles if possible.

**Lengthman's Report** – There has been some areas of road edge erosion reported. The lamp on the village green East Langdon has been reported to DDC

**East Langdon Parish Hall** – the Post Office is operating normal opening times under current Government Covid-19 restrictions. Roof works have been completed. Some work is required to replace decayed wall plate timber along the south wall.

West Langdon Parish Hall - Nothing to report.

**Langdon Playing Field** – There has been damage to some of the play equipment. The rubber seat to the zip line and hip-hop seat have been torn but the cause is unknown. It was suggested it might be animals. The donation box contained £19.00 when checked.
