There are 7 candidates contesting the 2 Ward seats. The five candidates nominated for Langdon Parish have been elected uncontested. A Notice of Vacancy will advertise the two vacant seats in May.

## **NEWS FROM ST AUGUSTINE'S CHURCH**

Our vicar for the four churches of the Benefice of St Margaret's including St Augustine, East Langdon and St Mary's, West Langdon has had to retire for reasons of ill health. Kaz only came here in March 2021 and her poor health seriously disrupted her last six months with us. We wish her well and hope she fully recovers. We are now in interregnum and will wait for the process of appointing a new vicar to begin. As always, St Augustine's remains fully open and operational.

Our replacement lath and plaster south aisle ceiling has been completed but we now await the rewiring of the chancel and south aisle before decoration can take place. It has been a lengthy process not helped by doing the work during the winter months. We remain hopeful that all work, removal of scaffolding, checking and retuning the organ plus giving everything a good clean can take place before the end of April.

Looking forward to seeing as many as possible on East Langdon Village Green at 10.00am on Sunday 7th May to celebrate the coronation of King Charles III.

## PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

#### **Dover District Council Draft Local Plan Update**

The Dover District Draft Local Plan to 2040 was submitted to the Secretary of State for independent examination on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023. This includes the land allocation in East Langdon (SAP46) for up to 40 dwellings. This site has also been submitted for outline planning approval before the Local Plan has been examined. (see next paragraph for details).

#### Planning Application DOV 23/00370

**Proposal:** Outline application for erection of up to 40 dwellings (matters reserved except access) **Location:** Land off The Street East Langdon CT15 5JF.

(The proposed development does not accord with the provisions of the development plan in force in the area in which the land to which the application relates is situated. The proposed plan is a departure from the development plan, affects a Right of Way and is a Major development.) Ref. DDC Public Planning Notice.

The parish council considered this application at an Extraordinary Meeting on Monday 27th March. The Public Speaking session heard strong opposition to the proposed outline development from the 30 members of the public. The parish council unanimously recommended refusal based on the proposal being contrary to the current District Core Policies.

The site lies outside the defined settlement boundary of East Langdon, on productive agricultural land. The proposed development would result in an unacceptable intrusion into the countryside, contrary to Core Strategies DM1, DM15, and National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) 2021, paragraphs 167,169. The additional 40 dwellings would increase the number of houses in the village by 60%. The narrow roads network of Langdon would suffer further congestion from the additional traffic movements.
